Description

This user-friendly DVD-ROM is a remarkable learning tool for orthopaedists, radiologists, and trainees, and clinicians involved in diagnosing trauma in the emergency room. The main feature of this DVD-ROM is a simulation of the diagnostic process at the light box.
